# **COOKING CORNER**

#### Creamy Tuscan Gnocchi (4 servings)

#### **Ingredients**

- 1 tablespoon butter
- 2-3 cloves minced garlic
- 3/4 cup heavy cream
- 2/3 cup chicken or veggie broth
- Salt and black pepper
- 1 pound potato gnocchi
- 1/3 cup oil-packed sundried tomatoes julienne style
- 1/2 cup freshly-grated parmesan cheese
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice
- 1 cup fresh baby spinach

#### **Directions**

- 1. Melt butter in a skillet over medium heat. Add garlic and cook for 30-60 seconds. Stir in cream and broth.
- 2. Bring to a simmer. Add gnocchi and sundried tomatoes. Cover and cook for 4 minutes.
- 3. Uncover and stir often until gnocchi is tender and the sauce is slightly thickened.
- 4. Stir in spinach, parmesan and lemon juice. Season with salt and pepper. Remove from heat when spinach wilts. Serve and enjoy!
